PORTLAND, Ore. — Northwest Children's Theater (NWCT) will bring its most popular production of all time, *Elephant & Piggie's "We Are In a Play!"*, to the Newmark Theatre for a special series of six student matinees, running February 10–12, 2026.

Directed by Sarah Jane Hardy, this school-matinee-only run responds to a significant programming gap at Portland's Centers for the Arts. For the 2025–26 season, student matinee programming is down significantly, especially in the Newmark Theatre. Meanwhile, school demand for field trips far exceeded what NWCT had scheduled at The Judy.

To meet this need, NWCT and Portland's are teaming up to bring *Elephant & Piggie's* joyful musical adventure right across the street to the Newmark Theatre. This limited engagement will serve more than 5,400 students in just one week, demonstrating how local arts organizations can collaborate to expand access, better serve the community, and bring thousands of people to downtown Portland.

"This pilot program is an important step toward addressing the overwhelming demand for school field trips in Portland," says NWCT

Managing Director Nick Fenster. "This pilot partnership with Portland's allows us to bring high-quality theater to many more students than we'd be able to serve at The Judy alone."

"Portland's is happy to support NWCT at the Newmark this year," says Portland's Executive Director Rachael Lembo. "Introducing young people to the performing arts is a transformative experience and can start a life-long love of the arts."

Elephant & Piggie's "We Are in a Play!" is presented in the Newmark Theatre at Portland's Centers for the Arts in downtown Portland, right across the street from Northwest Children's Theater's home, The Judy. Performances run February 10–12, 2026 with two showtimes each day: 9:30am and 11:45am.
