# Back by Popular Demand, Northwest Children's Theater Presents "Pete the Cat", a Live Rock Musical!

Get ready for a rockin' good time as Northwest Children's Theater (NWCT) brings back its wildly popular live rock musical, *Pete the Cat*, for a brand-new run at The Judy in downtown Portland. Running from January 31 through February 15, 2026 this encore production follows last year's near sell-out success and features the original cast returning to the stage.

Based on the beloved "Pete the Cat" book series, the musical celebrates the playful energy, creativity, and cool attitude of the ever-chill cat Pete, along with his best buddy Jimmy. As Pete helps Jimmy embrace the power of imagination, families will experience a joyful, visually vibrant show that highlights the whimsical world of Pete the Cat.

NWCT's Artistic Director Sarah Jane Hardy directs the production and is thrilled to remount a show that resonated so deeply with audiences. "Audiences absolutely loved this show last year, so it's a thrill to bring it back for even more families to enjoy," says Hardy. "It's a rock musical, and the music and visuals work together to create a truly immersive experience for kids and their families."

The musical follows Pete as he moves in with the Biddle family and befriends young Jimmy, a very organized second grader who struggles with creativity. When Jimmy hits a block in art class, Pete takes him on a fun, imaginative adventure to find inspiration, teaching him valuable lessons about friendship and embracing the unexpected—all while rocking out with catchy songs and a laid-back attitude.

Returning in the title role is Henry Martin, who has been part of NWCT since childhood. "It's always fun to return to a role and a show that you really loved," says Martin. "And getting to perform again with such a great cast makes it even better."

Families can expect a joyful and lively theater experience filled with humor, heart, and high-energy music as Pete and Jimmy's journey of imagination and self-discovery unfolds on stage.

Pete the Cat is presented on The Schnitzer Stage at The Judy in downtown Portland. Performances run January 31–February 15 with showtimes at 11am and 2pm. Additional weekday school matinee performances will bring thousands of students to The Judy for this special remount of one of NWCT's most popular recent productions.

NWCT offers a sensory-friendly performance of *Pete the Cat* on Sunday, February 1 at 2pm with pay-what-you-will tickets starting at \$5. These performances feature shorter run times,
